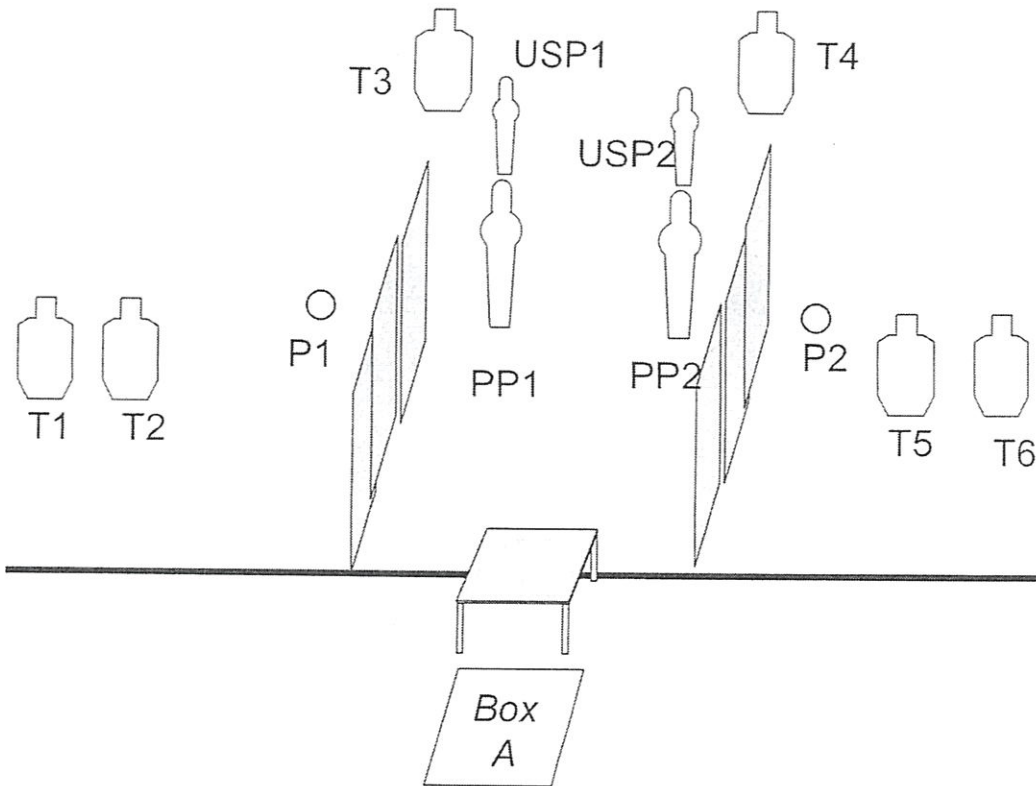
START POSITION: Standing in Box A facing downrange with hands naturally at sides. **Unloaded** Handgun and **a II** magazines or loading devices are fully on table. No part of the gun, magazines, or other loading devices shall be off of the table. Gun is laying flat and unsupported in ready condition as per Rule 8.1.3

STAGE PROCEDURE

At audible start engage all targets as they become visible from behind the fault line. All reloads must come from ammunition on the table.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 18 rounds, 90 points
TARGETS: 6 IPSC, 2 PP, 2 USP, 2 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES:

Set plates at 10 yards from fault line. Set Pepper Poppers at 10 yards from fault line. Set US Poppers at 12 yards from fault line. Walls to extend beyond US Poppers.

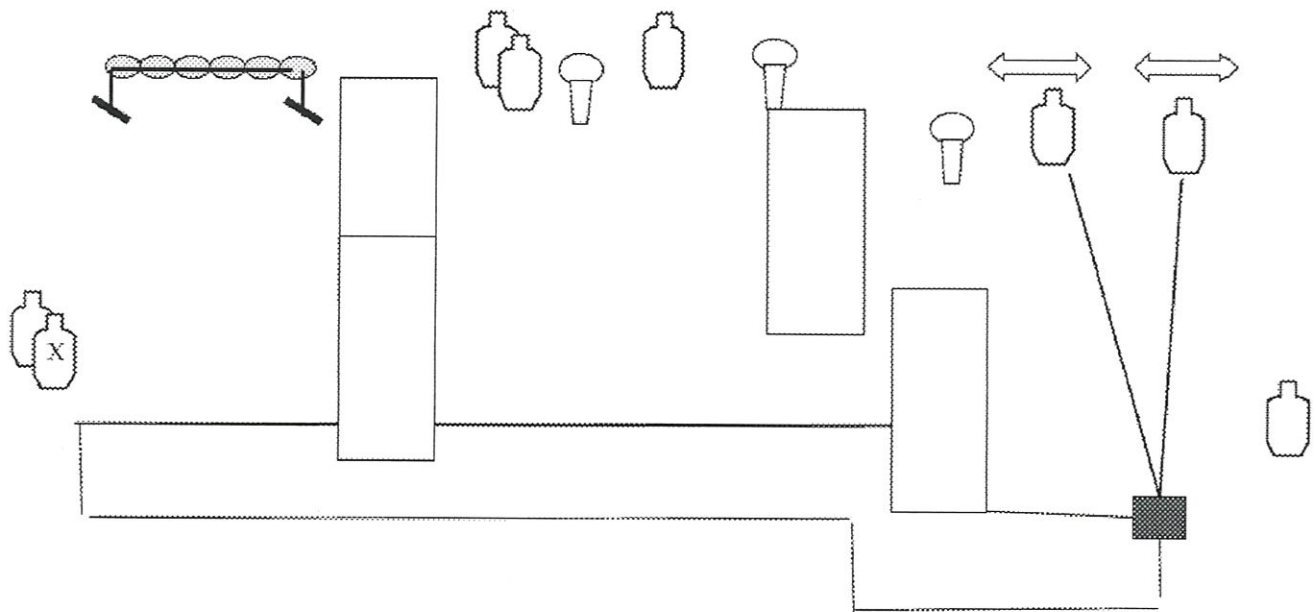
START POSITION: Feet inside fault lines, handgun is loader and holstered per 8.1.1, 8.1.2 PCC held with stock touching belt

On signal engage targets as they become visible from within fault lines.

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

Handgun Ready Condition: Handgun is **loaded** and holstered.

PCC Ready Condition: PCC is **loaded**, held stock on belt muzzle generally down range

Stage Procedure –

On audible start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area.

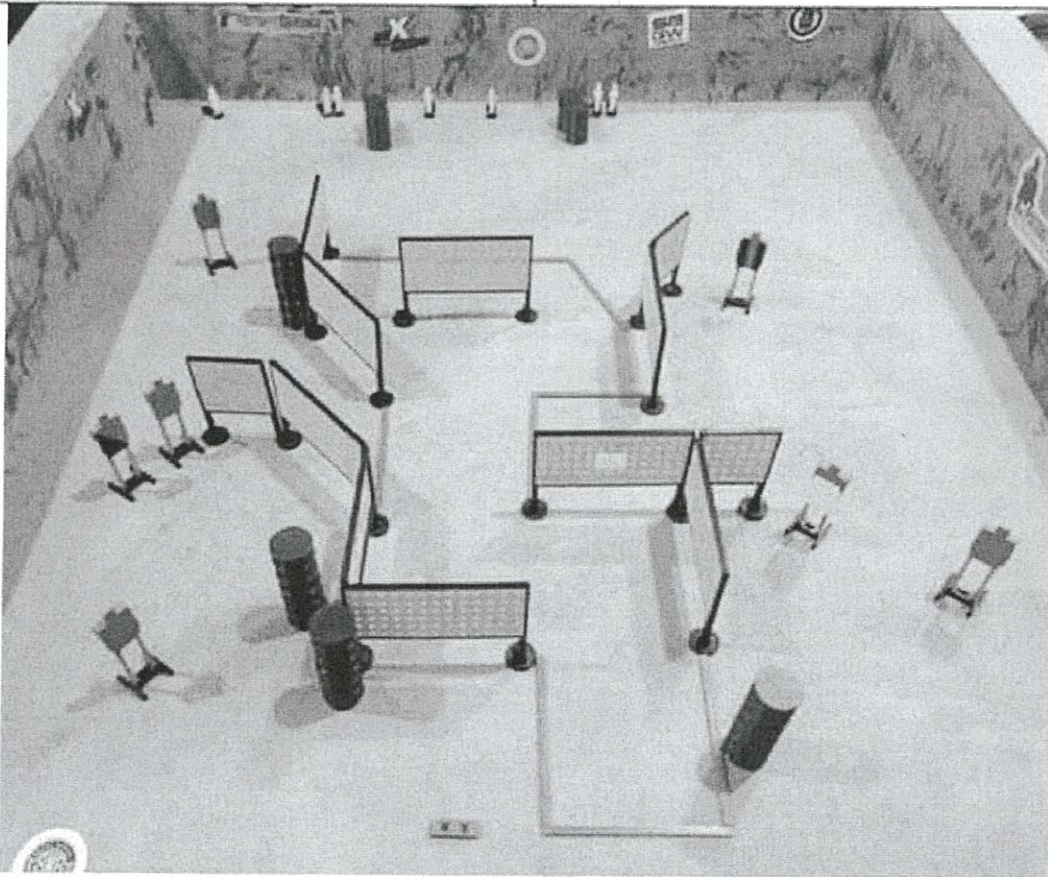
Steel must fall to score.

Scoring: Comstock 21 rounds 105 points

Targets: 7 Cardboard, 7 Steel

Scored Hits: Best 2 Per Cardboard

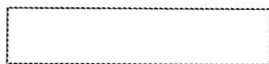
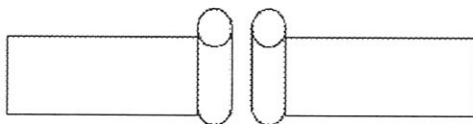
START POSITION: Feet inside with one Foot touching fault lines at any corner., handgun is loaded and holstered per 8.1.1, 8.1.2 PCC held with stock touching belt

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal engage targets as they become visible from within fault lines. 6 rounds per target.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 18 rounds , 90 points
TARGETS: 6 IPSC,
SCORED HITS: Best 6 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10

Hillbillton Drill

RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, current edition COURSE DESIGNER: Joe Cubigas—Modifications by US Design Team

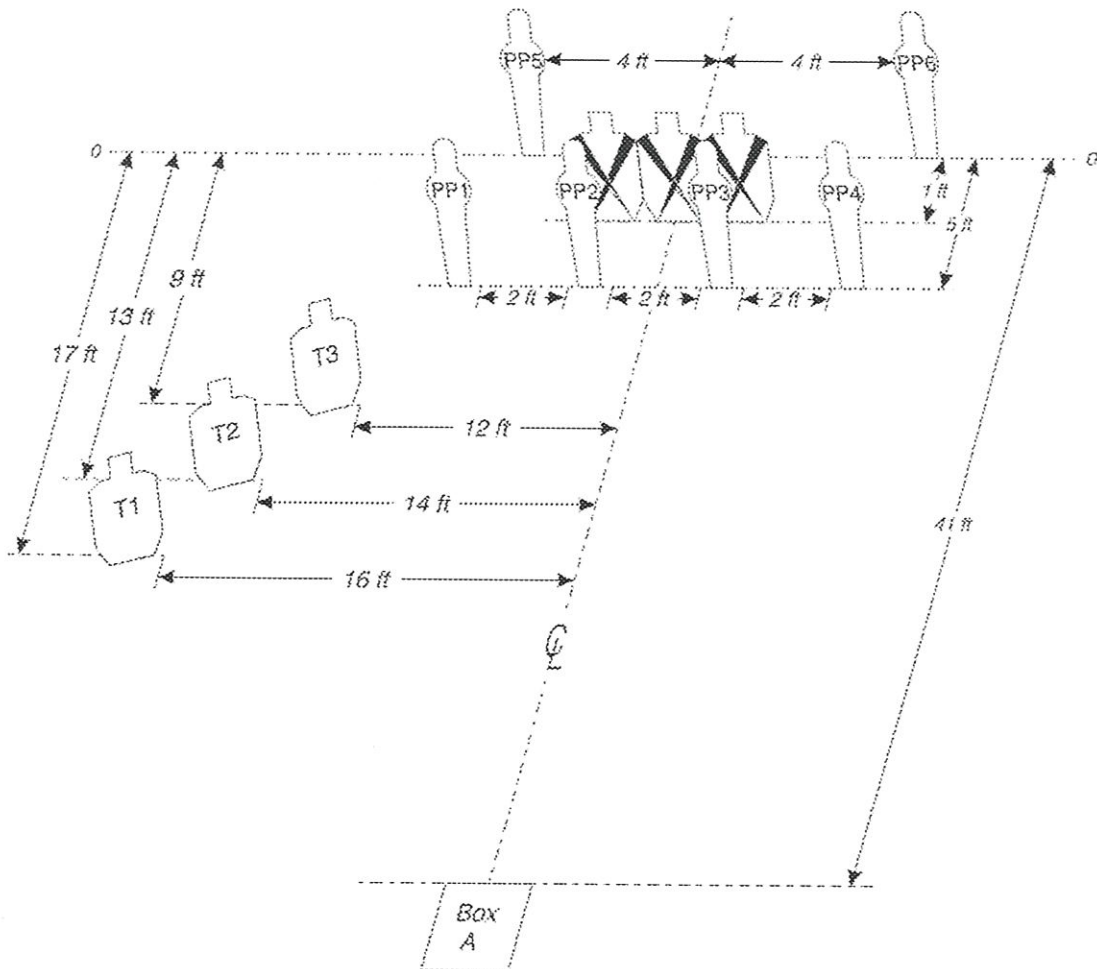
START POSITION: Standing in Box A facing targets with both wrists above respective shoulders. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, from Box A, engage only T1-T3, perform a mandatory reload, and from Box A engage PP1-PP6.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 12 rounds, 60 points
TARGETS: 3 Metric, 6 Pepper poppers
SCORED HITS: Best 2/paper, KD = 1 A
START - STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Handgun Competition Rules
Failure to perform the mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired.



SETUP NOTES: Angle T1-T3 toward shooting Box A with right edge of each target placed at distances indicated. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet. Set paper targets and no-shoots to 5 feet high at shoulders. No-shoots



are set with edges touching the next no-shoot. The array is then centered with the middle no-shoot centered on the center line.

CM 99-28 Hillbillton Drill

Written Stage Briefing

Hillbillton Drill is a 12 round, 60 point, Comstock Classifier course. There are 3 metric targets and 6 pepper poppers. The best two hits per paper target will score, steel must fall to score. The start signal is audible.

The start position is standing in Box A, facing the targets with your wrists above your respective shoulders. Your gun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is standing in Box A, facing downrange, stock on belt, muzzle downrange, loaded carbine held in both hands with safety on.

On the start signal, from within the fault lines, engage T1-T3, make a mandatory reload and engage PP1-PP6. Targets and poppers may be engaged in any order. Only one mandatory reload is required.
