**Targets:** 12 USPSA targets, 3 steel

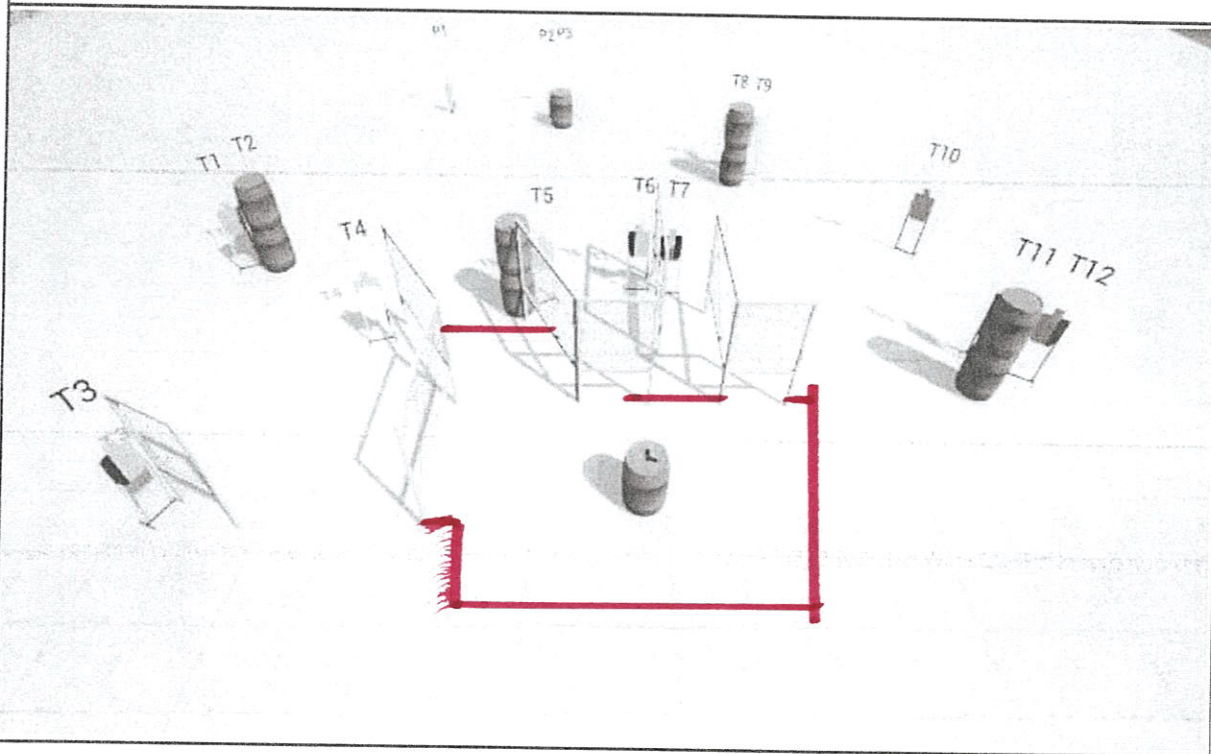
**Rounds:** 27

### Start Position:

The start position is standing in the shooting area, facing down range with wrists below belt. Firearm is unloaded and unpropped on barrel.

### Procedure:

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area.

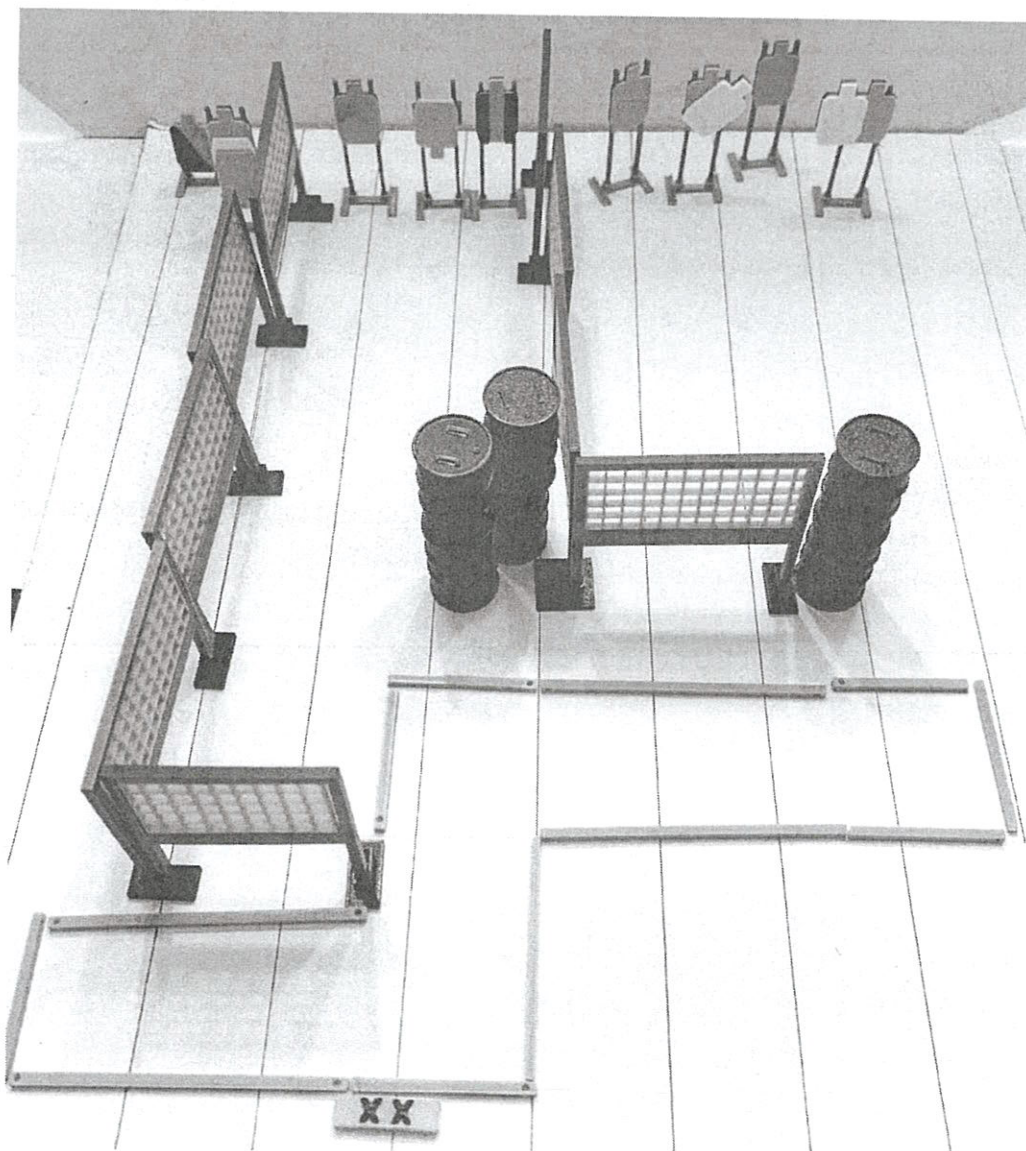
**START POSITION:** Feet on XX, handgun is loaded and holstered per 8.1.1, 8.1.2 PCC held with stock touching belt

### STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal engage targets as they become visible from within fault lines.

### SCORING

**SCORING:** Comstock, 20 rounds , 100 points  
**TARGETS:** 10 IPSC, ,  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A  
**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot  
**PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10  
No-shoot hit. -10  
Miss. -10

Stage 5

Targets:	6 IPSC Targets, 1 IPSC popper, 2 IPSC Metal plates
Number of rounds to be scored:	15
Start position:	Standing anywhere within designated area
Handgun Ready Condition:	Lying on the table, magazine inserted, chamber empty
Time starts:	Audible
Procedure:	After start signal engage all the targets from designated area. IP1 activate target T1. All moving targets stays visible at end of their movement
Safety angles:	90 degrees left/right and top of the backstop
